## **New Cohort for an Advanced Diploma in School Leadership and Technology**

### **Open to All Districts**

Another exciting opportunity from ITRC & NYIT will start in the **Spring 2009**. NYIT's **professional diploma in educational leadership and technology** is designed for you - a future educational administrator - with the knowledge you need to successfully integrate technology into 21<sup>st</sup> Century K-12 curriculum, professional development and school management. This professional diploma provides future administrators with the technology-based, forward thinking information to become highly qualified educational school leaders.

- **This program leads to dual certification: School Building Leader and Educational Technology Specialist certification.**
- Graduates gain fluency and skills in technology and knowledge of school leadership.
- The program provides a solid technical base for technology developments for school management and instruction.
- Emphasis is on professional development and long-range planning, acquisition, maintenance and use of technology in schools.

At this time, the special tuition is at the reduced rate of **\$830** (normal tuition is \$2,245). There is a \$100 administrative fee per semester payable to the Teacher Center at the time of course registration. Courses are a combination of traditional classroom environment and online. However, all leadership courses will be f-2-f. We are working with two districts as a possible host - the **new Roosevelt Middle School** and the **Glen Cove Schools**. One location will be determined, but the program is **open to all districts**.

Courses will be on a 10 week schedule, meeting once a week from approximately 4:30-8:15.  
Courses include:

- Organizational Behavior & Leadership
- Leadership in Technology
- Curriculum Design, Implementation & Assessment

- Leadership in Technology II
- Education Law, Policy & Ethics
- Educational Research
- Role of Computer Coordinator
- Developmental Supervision of Instructional Programs
- Administrative Internship & Seminar
- Staff Development & Human Resource Administration
- Resource Allocation

Program is limited enrollment to participants who join the cohort committed to completing the program in less than 1.5 years with the completion of 33 credits. Candidates are aspiring school/district leaders with goals of becoming technology coordinators and building level administrators. The typical candidate is a teacher with a master's degree, 3 years teaching experience, and permanent or professional NYS teacher certification. Successful candidates view educational technology as essential for advancing teaching and learning to preparing students for their future.
